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**MINUTES**

A meeting of the **Zoning Board of Appeals** was held on **May 1, 2018** and the meeting was called to order by Chairman Howard at 7:00 p.m.

The first matter of business was review of an application by **BRIAN SEVER**. He has 7 acres and wishes to keep farm animals on his property. He needs 10 acres. The property is located at 265 Longwoods Road. He said he has no close neighbors and he has 1 rooster, 2 cattle, 6 sheep, 10 turkeys, 12 chickens and 2 geese. He said the property is not fenced in. The matter was set down for a Public Hearing at 7:00 p.m. on May 22, 2018.

The next matter of business was the application of **NICHOLAS & ELAINE DILORENZO**. The Notice of Public Hearing was read. Mr. DiLorenzo could not appear. This matter has been placed on the agenda for the May 22, 2018 meeting to be heard after Mr. Sever's application.
