Special Meeting

A Special Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Pittstown was held July 17, 2024 at the Town Hall, Tomhannock, New York. Those present included Supervisor, Matthew Curley, Councilpersons, Tanya Lipinski, Erin Maxon and Jason Eddy. Councilman, Robert Russell was absent.

Supv. Curley called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion: Maxon, Second: Lipinski to pay voucher 197 from the July 8th meeting. Vote: Ayes – Lipinski, Maxon & Eddy; Nays – none; Abstains – Curley.

Supv. Curley reminded the Board that the Town received two bids for the solid waste collection for 2025/2026. Casella - \$1,014,294.00 and County Waste - \$1,329,909.84 for a two-year contract. Motion: Eddy; Second: Maxon to accept the bid from Casella for a two-year contract at a cost of \$1,014,294.00. Vote: Ayes – Lipinski, Maxon & Eddy; Nays – none; Abstains – Curley.

The Board agreed to discuss the Dog Control Officer's need for assistance. He is having surgery and cannot lift or do strenuous activity for 4 to 6 weeks. He was going to ask Kathy Hall to assist, but it is a long period of time to ask someone to cover for. He will be able to perform the light duties; his wife is familiar with the job and is willing to assist him. The Board agreed. Motion: Curley, Second: Eddy to appoint Karen DelVecchio as Dog Control Officer Assistant and pay her \$250.00 for the month of August. Vote: Ayes – all; Nays – none.

Motion: Eddy, Second: Lipinski to adjourn the meeting at 8:10 a.m. Vote: Ayes – all; Nays – none.
