Saturdays, January 8, 15, 22, 29 2022 from 9 a.m. to 12 noon

Saturday, February 26, 2022 from 9 a.m. to 12 noon

Saturday, March 26, 2022 from 9 a.m. to 12 noon

Thursday, March 31, 2022 from 5 p.m. to 8 p.m.

All taxes postmarked by February 3rd, 2022 will not be penalized.

Postmarked February 4, 2022 – February 28, 2022 taxes will be subject to a 1% penalty.

Postmarked March 1, 2022 – March 31, 2022 taxes will be subject to a 2% penalty.

**Amounts owed after February 3rd are at the bottom of your tax bill.**

If late notices are sent, there will be a \$2.00 late fee added to your bill.

**All taxes mailed or paid in person after March 13, 2022 must be paid by a money order, Cashier's check or cash! All checks will be returned to sender.**

After March 31, 2022, all taxes must be paid to the Rensselaer County Bureau of Finance, 1600 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Troy, New York 12180 (518)270-2780
